

RULES OF ASSEMBLY for REMOTE ANNUAL MEETINGS

RULE #1:

Remote Member participants shall be considered present for purposes of establishing a quorum.

RULE #2:

In the event of technical difficulties or equipment failure of any kind, all remote participants shall use genuine best efforts to correct the problem. If such issues cannot be corrected it is the intent of this Rule to proceed with the meeting without the participation of the remote Member so long as a quorum remains.

RULE #3:

A Motion or Resolution offered by an individual voting Realtor® Member, after receiving a second, shall be displayed electronically for the body to review while the Member is speaking to the motion or resolution.

RULE #4:

No Member shall speak in debate more than once on the same Motion or Resolution on the same day, or longer than five minutes, without permission of the Members granted by a two-thirds vote without debate.

RULE #5:

Each Member desiring to speak shall indicate their desire to be acknowledged by the chair using the main “chat” feature of the hosting platform. When seeking recognition, the Member shall indicate whether they speak in favor of or opposition to the Motion, making a motion to amend, raising a point of order, or calling the question. Members who do not join via the weblink will not have access to the chat feature and will not be recognized.

RULE #6:

The Chair will alternate members speaking on the question and shall not close discussion so long as any Member who has not exhausted their right to speak desires the floor. Any Member, duly recognized by the Chair, can, “Move the Previous Question” when no other debatable point is made by the Member at that time. Such a motion will require a second and a two-thirds majority vote from the Realtor® Members to end previous discussions and vote on the pending motion.

RULE #7:

The “chat” feature of the hosting platform shall only be used to seek recognition from the chair. Any individual making comments or questions through the chat, for reasons other than seeking recognition, are subject to disciplinary action and will be removed from the meeting.

RULE #8:

All participants must remain muted unless recognized by the Chair.

RULE #9:

Votes shall be taken via the Association online voting platform.
